

Scholarship Information Indiana Society of Professional Engineers

ELIGIBILITY

To qualify for the Scholarship, the applicant must meet all the following criteria and report the information substantiating the applicant's eligibility:

- The applicant, and his/her parents or legal guardian, must be residents of the State of Indiana, and the applicant shall attend an Indiana educational institution or be commuting daily to a school outside the State of Indiana.
- The applicant must have accrued the minimum of one-half the credits or credit hours required for an undergraduate ABET accredited engineering degree.
- The applicant may not be the legal dependent of any member of the Committee or Chapter Officers or Committeemen processing the applicant.

APPLICATION

Applications for the Scholarship are available from the Scholarship Committee Chairman of the local chapter of the Indiana Society of Professional Engineers, by writing to the Indiana Society of Professional Engineers headquarters at the Indianapolis address listed below, or at the ISPE Website (www.indspe.org).

Upon completion, the application and reference letters are to be submitted to the ISPE Chapter Scholarship Chairman.

SELECTION PROCEDURES

The ISPE Chapter Scholarship Committee will review the candidate application to assure completeness and verification of information, and to determine the candidate's eligibility. A member of the chapter will conduct a personal interview with the applicant.

In accordance with the date specified on the application, the Chapter Secretary will submit the completed file of the applicant to the ISPE Scholarship Committee which will make the selection of the scholarship award based upon the following criteria:

- Academic standing in an ABET accredited engineering program of study.
- Participation in extra curricular activities.
- Comments of teachers, administrators and society members who have conducted a personal interview with the applicant.

AWARD

The amount of the Scholarship will be a minimum of seven hundred and fifty dollars (\$750.00) awarded per academic year, and will be paid in two installments at the time of enrollment for the fall semester, or the equivalent for schools on a trimester or other system. In the event that the Scholarship recipient becomes ineligible before the second installment is paid, the second installment may be forfeited by action of the Committee.

The Indiana Society of Professional Engineers (ISPE), recognizing that an engineering education is the foundation upon which the engineering profession is constructed and also recognizing the need for encouragement and financial aid, has established a scholarship program to aid resident students of Indiana who have proven a genuine interest in an engineering career.

Students who are assisted by this program will be those whose scholastic records and personal qualifications indicate clearly that they merit the highest consideration by the Scholarship Committee. Details including eligibility, method of selection, application procedures and the amount of award are explained in this pamphlet.

It is our hope that these scholarships will be of lasting value to the promising young citizens and the engineering profession.
